#### Primary Purpose

The Scoring Media Liaisons are responsible for assisting Hour Glass to distribute the team lists, scratchings, results and ‘fluff’ from Hourglass Vision to Print Media and Broadcast. Hourglass are Competitions Systems Integrators. They manage the flow of information, track every player (Live & In Real Time), design and deliver Broadcast Graphics to the World Feed, drive the Big Screens, Keep Time, Tweet and Post.

#### Key Tasks

- Retrieving match statistics from Hourglass and distribute them to Media and Runners for wider distribution around the Stadium
- Ensuring Media areas have up-to-date game statistics for each match played
- Delegate tasks to the 2 Media Runners
- Assist the Media Operations Manager as required
